Upgrading the Pacific Highway

Bonville upgrade

This project is jointly funded by the Australian and New South Wales governments

The NSW Roads and Traffic Authority has engaged Abigroup Contractors Pty Ltd to undertake the design, construction and 10-year maintenance of the 9.6km Pacific Highway upgrade at Bonville.

Changes to traffic conditions

Works are almost complete on the Bonville upgrade with traffic to be switched onto the new alignment in the week commencing 15 September 2008.

To celebrate the opening of the project a community open day will take place on Sunday 14 September 2008.

After the new highway is open to traffic, part of the existing Pacific Highway between Overhead Bridge Road and Perrys Road will be temporarily closed to local traffic to allow for construction of the new Mailmans Track interchange to be completed.

While these works are taking place, motorists from the Bundagen area can access the new highway via Perrys Road and the new Archville Station Road interchange. Signposting will be in place to assist motorists.

Safety

Please observe all project signage and traffic control directions during construction.

Construction hours

Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm.

Nearby residents will be advised of any construction works occurring outside normal working hours.
