



## Upgrading the Pacific Highway

### Bonville upgrade

*This project is jointly funded by the Australian and New South Wales governments*

The NSW Roads and Traffic Authority has engaged Abigroup Contractors Pty Ltd to undertake the design, construction and 10-year maintenance of the 9.6km Pacific Highway upgrade at Bonville.

#### **Construction activities – July - September 2007**

Works are now underway along the entire length of the Bonville upgrade including all local roads. Works include:

- Earthworks will continue along the main alignment west of the speed camera – Mailmans Track.
- Concrete Pavement placement will commence from Overhead Bridge Road through to Bonville Creek.
- Saw cutting will commence from Pine Creek to Bonville Creek late August 2007 early September 2007.
- Finalising earthworks from Williams Road through to Lyons Road.
- All bridges works are underway with ongoing piling and the pouring of piers, abutments and decks.

#### **Changes to traffic conditions**

**Pacific Highway Traffic Switch** – from 25 July 2007, traffic at the southern end of the Bonville upgrade, from Overhead Bridge Road to Perrys Road, has been diverted along a section of the service road adjacent to the Pacific Highway.

**Mailmans Track Detour**- from 25 July 2007 motorists using the access road from the Pacific Highway to/from Mailmans Track, Bongil Bongil National Park will be temporary diverted to an alternate route via Hunters Road and Cabbage Tree Road or via Valery Repton Road.

#### **Safety**

Please observe all project signage and traffic control directions during construction.

#### **Construction hours**

Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm.

Nearby residents will be advised of any construction works occurring outside normal working hours.
