Upgrading the Pacific Highway

Bonville upgrade

This project is jointly funded by the Australian and New South Wales governments

The NSW Roads and Traffic Authority have engaged Abigroup Contractors Pty Ltd to undertake the design, construction and 10-year maintenance of the 9.6km Pacific Highway upgrade at Bonville.

Traffic will be switched onto the new alignment in the week commencing Monday 15 September 2008.

To celebrate the opening of the project a community open day will take place on Sunday 14 September 2008. **Activities will commence from 9.30am to 2pm and include:**

- SES static display
- Petting zoo
- Face painters
- circus performers

- Westpac rescue helicopter
- Rotary club sausage sizzle

Further roadworks, including completion of roundabouts at Archville Station Road and Mailmans Track, and local road connections near Lyons Road, will be undertaken after the new highway is open to traffic. RTA regrets any inconvenience to road users while these works are taking place.
