



Bonville upgrade Upgrading the Pacific Highway

Dear resident,

The Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) has contracted Abigroup Contractors Pty Ltd to design, construct and maintain for ten years the Pacific Highway Bonville upgrade.

This 9.6 km upgrade of the Pacific Highway commences in the south adjacent to Perrys Road, bypassing Bonville village, and finishes at the junction of Lyons Road, approximately 11 km south of Coffs Harbour.

While a range of dust mitigation measures will be employed on the project, a **'first flush' water diverter** has also been identified as an effective tool early in the construction process to further reduce any pollutants collected in the rainwater tanks of property owners.

Prior to the commencement of major construction, Abigroup will provide residents close to the project that may be affected by construction of the highway with a 'first flush' rainwater diverter.

Your residence has been selected as qualifying for the installation of a first flush water diverter. You will be contacted shortly to discuss permission to commence the process of installation.
