Bonville upgrade Upgrading the Pacific Highway

Dear resident

The NSW Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) has contracted Abigroup Contractors Pty Ltd to design, construct and maintain for ten years the Pacific Highway Bonville upgrade. This project is jointly funded by the NSW and Australian governments.

This 9.6 km upgrade of the Pacific Highway commences in the south adjacent to Perrys Road, bypassing Bonville village and finishes at the junction of Lyons Road, approximately 11 km south of Coffs Harbour. When complete, it will provide continuous dual carriageway between Coffs Harbour and Raleigh.

From Wednesday 19 December, local road traffic using Archville Station Road will be diverted over the newly completed Archville Station Road Bridge. Traffic will be directed through roundabouts at either end of the bridge.

This will be a permanent arrangement for Archville Station Road traffic, although access ramps to the new highway from Archville Station Road will not be completed and available to traffic until the second half of 2008.

Motorists are requested to take extra care during the implementation of these changed traffic arrangements.

Construction work hours are Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm and Saturday from 8am to 1pm.

Nearby residents will be advised of any construction activities occurring outside normal working hours. Abigroup apologises for any inconvenience that may be caused and asks for your patience during this period.
